Over the next few weeks Asda will be issuing details of exactly what these contracts entail. They will be paid at an extra £1.00 per hour, but there will be fundamental differences such as unpaid breaks, changes to Bank Holiday pay etc.

GMB are here to assist members who have questions and need help in evaluating how this voluntary change would affect them as individuals.
